

If you worked as a sales clerk for Tire Club USA, Inc., Tires Auto Service, LLC, or Fernando Aguirre, Jr., you may be owed unpaid wages.

Why Am I Getting This Notice?

You have been identified as an individual who worked for Tire Club USA, Inc., Tires Auto Service, LLC, or Fernando Aguirre, Jr. as a sales clerk between October 2015 and the present. If you have received this Notice, you may be affected by this lawsuit.

What's This About?

Former workers filed a collective action lawsuit seeking to recover unpaid overtime wages for themselves and other individuals who worked for Tire Club USA, Inc., Tires Auto Service, LLC, and Fernando Aguirre, Jr. The lawsuit claims that these workers:

- Were paid on an hourly basis;
- Worked more than forty hours per week;
- Were not paid overtime premiums for hours worked over forty.

If you worked as a sales clerk for Tire Club USA, Inc., Tires Auto Service, LLC, and Fernando Aguirre, Jr. at any point from October 15, 2015 to the present, you have a choice to assert your legal rights in this case if you desire to do so. If you do not choose to assert your rights in this case, you will not share in any money awarded in the case.

What Are My Choices?

If you choose to join in this case, you will be bound by the result in this case, whether it is favorable or unfavorable. If you join the lawsuit, you will *not* have to pay the lawyers *anything* out of pocket—win or lose. If you do not wish to join the lawsuit as a plaintiff, you are free to take action on your own or do nothing.

What Can I Get?

If the workers win, you may get an amount up to two times the unpaid overtime wages you should have received as well as attorneys' fees and costs.

Can I be Fired or Retaliated Against?

It is unlawful for Tire Club USA, Inc., Tires Auto Service, LLC, and Fernando Aguirre, Jr. or your current employer to terminate or take any adverse action, as defined by the law, as a result of your participation in this suit.

How Do I Join the Lawsuit?

If you want to participate in the lawsuit, fill out the enclosed *Consent to Join* form and mail or fax it back. It must be received by **[60 days from the date mailed]**.
