IMPORTANT NOTICE TO CURRENT AND FORMER DELIVERY DRIVERS

EMPLOYEES OF MUY PIZZA-TEJAS, LLC AND MUY PIZZA MINNESOTA, LLC

If you worked as a delivery driver for MUY Pizza-Tejas, LLC or MUY Pizza Minnesota, LLC (“Defendants”) at any time after November 14, 2015, YOU MAY BE ENTITLED TO JOIN A LAWSUIT SEEKING UNPAID WAGES AND LIQUIDATED DAMAGES.

1. Why Are You Getting this Notice?

Ernest Scott and Evan Monacelli (the “Plaintiffs”) filed a lawsuit against Defendants contending that they and other delivery drivers are owed money because unreimbursed automobile expenses brought their hourly pay below minimum wage. Defendants deny these claims and contend that Plaintiffs and other delivery drivers have been properly compensated.

The United States District Court for the Western District of Texas has conditionally certified a collective action class consisting of “All individuals who worked for defendants MUY Pizza Tejas, LLC or MUY Pizza Minnesota, LLC as delivery drivers at any time from November 14, 2015 to the present who did not sign an arbitration agreement with a class action waiver.”

In conditionally certifying the collective class and this Notice, the Court is not expressing any opinion regarding the merits of Plaintiffs’ claims or Defendants’ defenses. This Notice is provided for the sole purpose of determining the identity of persons who may be entitled and wish to participate in this lawsuit.

2. What are Your Options?

Defendants’ records show that you may be in the collective class of workers covered by this lawsuit. This gives you two options:

Option 1: RETURN THIS FORM	Join the lawsuit If you choose to be included in the lawsuit, you may return your consent form in one of these ways: 1. Option 2: DO NOTHING	Do not join this lawsuit. By doing nothing, you give up the possibility of getting money from a trial or settlement of this lawsuit if any money is awarded. However, you retain the ability to sue Defendants separately about the same or related claims, to the extent otherwise permitted by law.

This is a Court-Authorized Notice, Not an Advertisement from a Lawyer.

If you want to make a claim for unpaid wages in this case, you may mail, email, or electronically submit the attached Consent to Join form and information sheet to Plaintiffs' counsel (contact information below). If you timely mail, fax, or email a Consent to Join form to Plaintiffs' counsel, you will be part of the case, and will agree to be represented by Plaintiffs' counsel. You may also obtain counsel of your own choosing (at your own expense), who can file your Notice of Consent with the Court. If Plaintiffs win or settle the case, you may receive additional money from the Defendants. If Plaintiffs lose, you will receive nothing. If you join this lawsuit, you may or may not be required to provide records, answer written questions, testify under oath, or any combination of these.

Your decision not to join this lawsuit will not affect any rights you may have to pursue claims on your own. However, the legal time limit to make a claim is running.

You have the right to participate in this case regardless of your immigration status and no one will be permitted to inquire about your immigration status in this case.

You have the right to join this lawsuit even if you already signed any statement denying that you are owed any additional compensation, or if you have signed a severance agreement that purports to release any claim you may have for unpaid wages under the Fair Labor Standards Act, 29 U.S.C. §201, *et seq.*

Defendants may not retaliate against you or mistreat you in any way for joining this lawsuit. The law prohibits employers from discriminating or retaliating against you if you choose to take part in this case. This means that you cannot be fired, demoted, or have your pay cut because you participate in this case.

If you want to join the lawsuit and make a claim for unpaid wages, your signed Consent to Join form must be electronically submitted, postmarked, emailed, or faxed to the attorneys listed below by [Date].

If you do not wish to join, you do not have to do anything.

By filing this consent, I understand that I designate the Named Plaintiffs, hereinafter the “Representative Plaintiffs,” as my agents to make decisions on my behalf concerning Fair Labor Standards Act litigation against Defendants including the method and manner of conducting this litigation, entering into settlement agreements, entering into agreements with Representative Plaintiffs’ counsel concerning attorneys’ fees and costs, and all other matters pertaining to Fair Labor Standards Act Litigation against Defendants. These decisions and agreements made and entered into by the Representative Plaintiff will be binding on me if I sign this consent.

I understand that the Representative Plaintiffs have entered into a Representation Agreement (“Representation Agreement”) with Moreland Verrett, P.C. (“Law Firm”) which applies to all plaintiffs who file this consent. If I sign this consent, I agree to be bound by the Representation Agreement. I further understand that I may obtain a copy of the Representation Agreement by requesting it from Representative Plaintiffs’ counsel.

I agree and understand that the Law Firm and/or the Representative Plaintiffs may in the future appoint other individuals to be Representative Plaintiffs in Fair Labor Standards Act Litigation against Defendants. I consent to such appointment and agree to be bound by the decisions of such new Representative Plaintiff(s) for all purposes related to Fair Labor Standards Act Litigation against Defendants. I further acknowledge that this consent is intended to be filed to recover my wages against Defendants whether in the action with the Named Plaintiffs or in any subsequent action that may be filed on my behalf for such recovery. This consent may be used in this case or in any subsequent case as necessary.

By choosing to file this consent, I understand that I will be bound by a judgment of the court. I will also be bound by, and will share in any settlement that may be negotiated on behalf of all Plaintiffs.

I consent to join in the action.
